Troy Community Concert Band 17th Annual Thanksgiving Day Turkey Trot Information and Registration Form 2023

General Info. Thanks for choosing our local, family-friendly event that benefits the community band and Troy R3 Schools Buddy Bag Program. The route is an out and back, five kilometer course using Troy's city streets. It includes a significant hill going down at the start of mile 1 and going up at about the 2.5 mile mark. Participants may run or walk the course. Participants are required to have and wear their assigned number on the front exterior of their outermost piece of clothing so that it is visible at all times. There are no water stations on the route.

Potties. Two portable potties provided by the City of Troy will be available in the park – one in the main parking lot near the soccer field and one in the south ballfield parking lot. Please plan accordingly.

Breakfast. Volunteers will help participants put together a breakfast bag to take home after they finish their race. Head to the pavilion!

T-Shirts. This year's theme is: Stay the Path. Participants wanting the collectible, long sleeve t-shirt must pre-register by 11/17 at the upcharged rate of \$25.00. All registrations will be notified by email when their shirt is ready for pick up. Pick up can be made in store after notification or on event day starting at 7:30am. After the November 17th deadline, extra shirts will be available in order of receipt of fully completed, signed, and fully paid registrations. <u>Not guaranteed to race day registrants</u>
