General Info. Thanks for choosing our local, family-friendly event that benefits the community band and Troy R3 Schools Buddy Bag Program. The route is an out and back, five kilometer course using Troy's city streets. It includes a significant hill going down at the start of mile 1 and going up at about the 2.5 mile mark. Participants may run or walk the course. Participants are required to have and wear their assigned number on the front exterior of their outermost piece of clothing so that it is visible at all times. There are no water stations on the route.

Potties. Two portable potties provided by the City of Troy will be available in the park – one in the main parking lot near the soccer field and one in the south ballfield parking lot. Please plan accordingly.

Breakfast. Volunteers will help participants put together a breakfast bag to take home after they finish their race.

T-Shirts. This year's theme is: Our Sweet 16. Participants wanting the collectible t-shirt must pre-register by 11/17 at the upcharged rate of \$25.00. All registrations will be notified by email when their shirt is ready for pick up. Pick up can be made in store after notification or on event day starting at 8:00am. After the November 17th deadline, extra shirts will be available in order of receipt of fully completed, signed, and fully paid registrations.

Dogs. Leashed, canine friends are welcome. Please be considerate of others in the handling of your pooch - including any public or private property you may tread upon. A treat, bottle of water, and paper bowl will be awarded to canine finishers again this year!

The Route.

START: Skate Park Stop Sign
South on Mallard to Monroe
West on Monroe through park to 3rd Street (1.1 mile walkers turn around here)
South on 3rd Street to Fast Lane
TURN AROUND
North on 3rd Street to Monroe
East on Monroe through park

FINISH: Covered Pavilion Parking Lot Entrance

Where is Fairgrounds Park?

From Troy's Hwy 47/Hwy 61 intersection:

- Head west on 47
- Turn left at the McDonald's stop light
- Go straight at the Cherry Street stop light
- Go straight at the Phillips 66 stop sign
- Fairgrounds Park is on your right
- Parking is available in the park

The Food Donation. We are collecting donations for the Troy R3 Buddy Bag Program. In accordance with what the program needs to best help students, each person/registration completed prior to event day should bring the following 3 items:

- 1 - box of 8/12 Pop Tarts or 6/8 pack of peanut butter/cheese filled crackers, and
- 1 - pasta in a can (like Chef Boyardee or Spaghettios) or canned soup (like Campbells Chunky) NOTE: Either should have pop top please, and
- 1 - 4-pack of applesauce or fruit cups (like Motts, Musselmans, Dole or Del Monte)

Food donations are collected when you register in-store. Those who register by mail should bring their food donation when picking up their race number/t-shirt (whether at store or on Thanksgiving). Picking up for another or for a group? Please have all food donations with you. Race numbers with verified food donations will be entered into the Back At Ya' drawing for a chance to win a \$50 gift card. Thanks for being generous!

The Fine Print: Acknowledgements and Waivers.

_____ (my initials) The basic, pre-registration, entry fee is \$15.00 plus a food donation outlined above. Participants wanting the 2022 promotional t-shirt should register by November 17th at the higher \$25.00 entry level which still requires a food donation (see above). Food donations should be brought when you register by walk-in, or can be brought to the registration table on Thanksgiving Day. Food donations will be given to the Troy R3 Buddy Bags program. **If registration forms are postmarked after November 14th or turned in after November 17th including on the day of the event, the entry fee is \$30.00.** Entry fee is non-refundable. Event is held rain or shine, sleet or snow. Children 8 and younger do not need to register. All children (14 years or younger) MUST be accompanied by an adult (18 years or older) at all times. All participants are required to have and wear a participant number on the front exterior of their outermost piece of clothing so that it is visible at all times. The course is over open city streets. Participants are responsible for their own welfare including being able to see and hear their surroundings.
